The croix de guerre was imusel for his bravery. comment und coneral attitude under severe fire in battle. The chation is signed by Marshal Petain, commander or the French army. Mr Hurlbutt jwas a member of the United States a; Sankury Teain unit No. 618, and had jonly been at home for a short time - before the accident. This is another distribute to the bravery of Westport hors in action. It is probable that the - merited honors will be sent to tho n father, Horace C. Hurlbutt, of Nore ffield.

The deceased soldier was well known in Norwalk and his untimely death was greatly regretted.
